## **BASIC AUDIT REPORT**

South Central Mercer Fire District Mercer County 640 Cooper Ave. St. Henry, Ohio 45883

We have completed certain procedures in accordance with Ohio Rev. Code Section 117.01(G) to the accounting records and related documents of the South Central Mercer Fire District, Mercer County, (the Fire District) for the years ended December 31, 2022 and 2021.

Our procedures were designed solely to satisfy the audit requirements of Ohio Rev. Code Section 117.11(A). Because our procedures were not designed to opine on the Fire District's financial statements, we did not follow *generally accepted auditing standards*. We do not provide any assurance on the Fire District's financial statements, transactions or balances for the years ended December 31, 2022 and 2021.

The Fire District's management is responsible for preparing and maintaining its accounting records and related documents. Our responsibility under Ohio Rev. Code Section 117.11(A) is to examine, analyze and inspect these records and documents.

Based on the results of our procedures, we found the following significant compliance or accounting issues to report.

## **Current Year Observations**

- 1. We noted the Fire District did not adopt a public records policy. Ohio Rev. Code § 149.43(E)(2) requires all public offices to adopt a public records policy in compliance with this section for responding to public records requests. The Fire District should properly adopt a public records policy and take all steps regarding the policy required under Ohio Rev. Code § 149.43. Failure to establish and maintain a public records policy may result in records of the Fire District not being available for public inspection or request and could lead to noncompliance with the Ohio Revised Code.
- 2. We noted the Fire District did not have an established and adopted/approved records retention schedule/policy. Ohio Rev. Code § 149.43(B)(2) provides that a public office or the person responsible for public records shall organize and maintain public records in a manner that they can be made available for inspection or copying and that public offices shall have available a copy of their current records retention schedule at a location readily available to the public. The Fire District should appropriately establish and approve/adopt a records retention schedule/policy and have the records retention schedule at a location readily available to the public. Failure to have and follow a records retention schedule/policy could result in public records being disposed of prematurely.

#### **Current Status of Matters Reported in our Prior Engagement**

1. Our prior engagement noted that the Fire District did not have a public records policy or have a records retention schedule/policy. Ohio Rev. Code Section 149.43 requires the Fire District to adopt a public records policy, have a copy of its records retention schedule at a location that is readily available to the public, and other public records requirements. These matters were not corrected for the years ended December 31, 2022 and 2021, and are repeated in #1 and #2 above.
