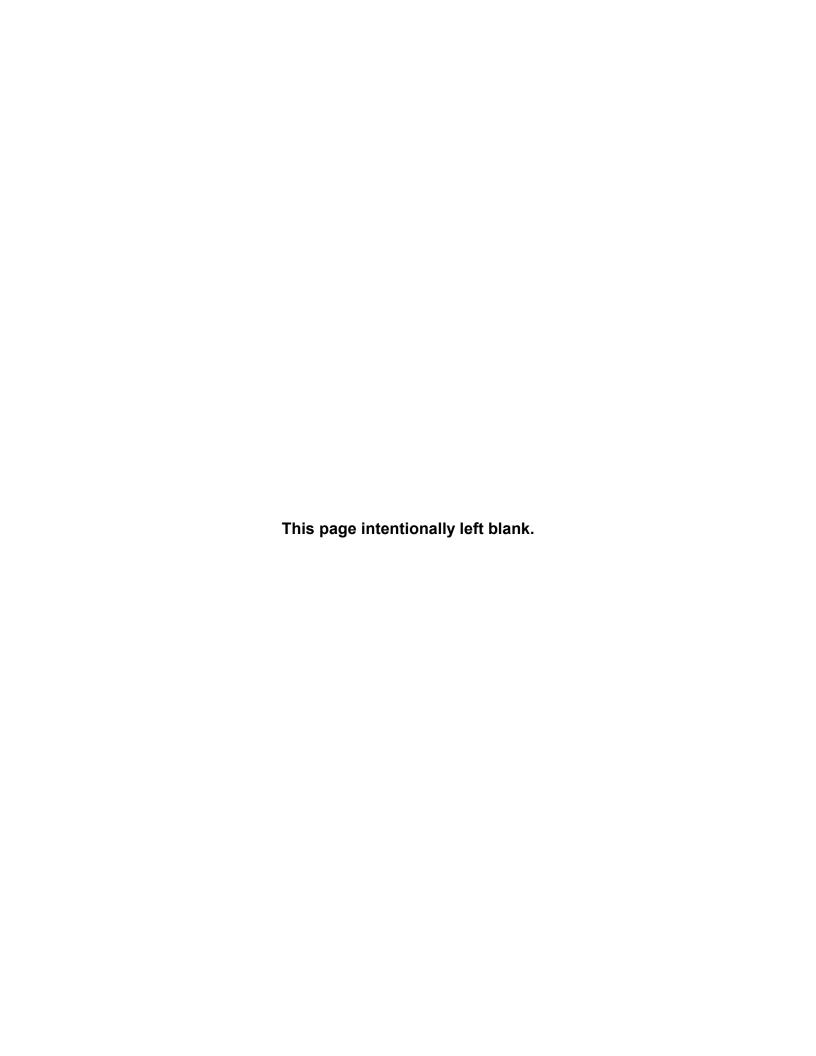

REPORT OF INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS

To the Executive Committee:

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the officials of the Democratic Party Executive Committee, Hocking County, solely to comply with the requirements of Ohio Revised Code § 3517.17. This engagement to apply agreed-upon procedures was performed in accordance with standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the specified users of the report. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

The procedures and associated findings, if any, are as follows:

Cash Receipts

We confirmed the Ohio Political Party Fund receipts with the State of Ohio and agreed to amounts shown on the Political Party Fund Finance Report.

We found no exceptions as a result of our procedures.

Cash Reconciliation

We compared the sum of the cash balances recorded on the Political Party Fund Finance Report with cash balances recorded on the bank reconciliation for the Democratic Party as of December 31, 2000. We recomputed the mathematical accuracy of the reconciliation.

We also agreed reconciling items appearing on that reconciliation to canceled checks, deposit slips, or to other documentation. We determined that the dates on those documents support that those items were proper reconciling items at December 31, 2000.

We found no exceptions as a result of our procedures.

Cash Disbursements

- 1. We confirmed the mathematical accuracy of the cash disbursement listing and compared the listing totals to the disbursement totals on the Political Party Fund Finance Report.
- We traced the recorded disbursements to source documentation. We also determined that the checks corresponded to the names on the invoices and that the checks were signed by authorized signatories and endorsed by the payee.
- 3. We vouched the disbursement transactions for compliance with Ohio Revised Code § 3517.18.

We found no exceptions as a result of our procedures.
